

COVID-19 (“CORONAVIRUS”)

The Retina Surgery Center Testing Protocol

COVID-19 test is required prior to your scheduled elective surgery.

AT HOME COVID TESTS ARE NOT ACCEPTED. PCR or RAPID ANTIGEN TESTS ONLY.

It is patient’s responsibility to provide us with the test results before elective eye surgery. If you do not have your test, your surgery may be postponed.

Plan to get tested 48-72 hours before surgery (2-3 days) or use guidelines below:

<u>If you have your eye surgery on:</u>	<u>Have SARS-CoV-2 Preoperative Testing on:</u>
Monday	Friday or Saturday the week before
Tuesday	Friday or Saturday the week before
Wednesday	Sunday or Monday same week
Thursday	Monday or Tuesday same week
Friday	Tuesday or Wednesday same week

- Choose any testing site in your area or contact your Primary Care Physician for testing or one of the suggested locations on the list that is provided to you. Inform the surgery scheduler which site you plan to go to, they will send the orders to the site if needed.
- Ask for or print a paper copy of your results to bring with you on the day of surgery. Give the testing site our fax number so we can receive your results.
